Why should I enrol in a tertiary preparation program?

**The USQ Tertiary Preparation Program is a FREE, onsite 16 week course that will equip you with all the skills you need to succeed at university. The course covers topics such as academic writing and referencing based around the theme of 'happiness and personal wellbeing', identifying your learning style, balancing study and life commitments and basic mathematics.**

Once you have finished TPP you receive automatic entry into the extensive range of undergraduate courses at USQ. No QTAC applications, no need for an OP, no competition.
